<p>Renata (B class) Skill Development Class</p>	<p>Welcome to Skill Development Class. I am so excited to start the year with my ESL students. My name is Mrs. Renata and I have been teaching for over 17 years and have two Masters degrees in Education. I am passionate about academics and plan to make this year fun and full of learning. These ESL students will review the basics of English starting with the alphabet and letter sounds and primarily focus on a more advanced understanding of the English language. Phonics, reading and writing are the focus of this Skill Development Class. This class is for students who may be learning to read and write English for the first time or who have had limited schooling in the English language. Content includes parts of speech, sentence structure, sight words, handwriting, and practicing the production of sounds, words, and phrases.</p> <p>In April we shared what we did over break and learned about new adventures. We learned Spring vocabulary terms and discussed the season of Spring in the United States. The class created colorful Spring flowers filled with our ESL goals for this year. The students wrote sentences about their goals on each petal.</p>

In Early English Class, 1st through 3rd ESL students were taught the basic foundation of the English language starting with the alphabet and letter sounds. We worked on phonics and sight words, as well as basic vocabulary terms. Students worked on letter formation and handwriting, as well as being exposed to multiple genres of literature. This class is designed to prepare students for the NJJS Skill Development Class.

In April we learned about Spring and seasonal vocabulary. We read books about Spring. The class also shared what we did over spring break and wrote adjectives about our adventures. I look forward to a terrific year ahead with my class.
