In September we continued to draw pictures about our weekend and then wrote a sentence about it in their journals. They learned new sight words and started to read sentences using the sight words they learned. During spelling and phonics, I have shown them how to sound out a word. We use a tapping method with our fingers. They are to tap out each sound using a finger. The class also has been practicing their short letter sounds every class. I am so proud of how hard they worked this month on memorizing their Maple Festival speeches and songs.

In September we:

- learned short "o" and short "u".
- reviewed the alphabet and letter sounds.
- continued with learning new sight words.
