They continued to do a wonderful job memorizing their sight words. We took some time over the past two months to really focus on our phonics skills. This is a critical component for them to begin to read. They learned look, go, and we.</li> <li>● reviewed winter vocabulary and Valentine’s Day vocabulary.</li> <li>● learned short “i” and practiced reading three- to four-word sentences with short “i”.</li> <li>● watched a short video and read a <i>Scholastic News</i> article about Groundhog Day and Presidents’ Day.
